Or take a guided hike to visit Pulgas Ridge, home to the Dusky Footed Wood Rat and several early blooming wild flowers, plus the ruins of Hassler Home. The noon hike is about two miles on a paved road and is suitable for jogging strollers. The elevation gain is 400 ft. The 2:30 PM hike is about three miles, on a single track trail, and is suitable for children 6yrs and older. Bikes are not allowed on either trail but the family dog, on leash, is welcome.
